

This is basic information about the **Impaired Driver Intervention Programs** offered by **Amethyst Foundation**. You may also visit our website at amethystfoundation.com or call our office **(603) 679-2100** or **1-800-327-1114**.

Impaired Driver Intervention Programs (IDIP): IDIP Courses (**22 hours**) are offered in several locations throughout New Hampshire. The fee for the IDIP, set by the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (**DHHS**) and specified by administrative rule (He-A 700) is **\$460.00**. **Out-of-State** license holders with **Out-of-State** convictions are charged **\$450.00**. A **\$50.00** deposit is required to enroll. The balance is due by the end of the IDIP. **Amethyst Foundation cannot accept out-of-state personal/business checks.**

Claremont: Three (3) sessions, the first class is on **Saturday** and the second class on **Sunday** (the next day). The third class is held the following **Saturday**. Classes run from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm (20 classroom hours).

Epping: Six (6) Class sessions are held on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** evenings, from 6:00 to 9:15 pm, for three (3) consecutive weeks, (20 classroom hours).

Hanover/Lebanon: Three (3) sessions, the first class on **Saturday** and the second class on the next day, **Sunday**. The third class is the following **Saturday**. Classes run from 8:30am to 3:30 pm (20 classroom hours).

Portsmouth: Six (6) Class sessions are held on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** evenings, from 6:00 to 9:15 pm or * three (3) weekend sessions from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm (20 classroom hours). The first class is on **Saturday** and the second class on **Sunday** (the next day). The third class is held on the following **Saturday**.

Salem: * Six (6) sessions held on **Monday** and **Wednesday** evenings, from 6:00 to 9:15 pm, or * three (3) sessions on **Saturdays**, from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm for three (3) consecutive weeks (20 classroom hours).

Weekend Impaired Driver Intervention Program (WIDIP)

The **WIDIP** is conducted at **Amethyst House** in Epping, NH. The fee, set by **NH DHHS**, is **\$585.00** for drivers with New Hampshire residences or convictions. **Out-of-state** license holders with **out-of-state** convictions are charged **\$545.00**. Full payment is required before dates are confirmed. Amethyst makes every effort to enroll clients within thirty (30) days of receipt of payment. **WIDIP** begins on **Friday** at 3:00 pm and ends on **Sunday** at 3:00 pm. The **WIDIP** is a residential program; clients **must** remain the entire weekend (20 class hours).

Phase II (Second Offender) Program

Phase II is a seven (7) day residential program held at **Amethyst House** in Epping. The maximum fee, set by **NH DHHS**, is **\$1,550.00**, although the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules (He-A 900) allows Amethyst to charge **\$1,240.00**. A deposit of **\$200.00** is required to confirm enrollment. The remaining **\$1,040.00** is due on the Friday of arrival. **Phase II** begins **Friday** at 2:00 pm and ends the following **Friday** at 2:00 pm. Interviews are done during the program. Clients **must** remain the entire week.

Intake Interview: A one (1) hour **Intake Interview** is required for enrollment in all programs. The interview consists of program registration, an oral interview and the completion of diagnostic instruments.

Assessment Interview: A one (1) hour **Assessment Interview** is required as a component of all programs except for **out of state** residents with **out of state** convictions. This interview is conducted by a Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LADC). Individual assessments and treatment plans are formulated, consistent with the guidelines specified in New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules **He-A 700**.

Certified Motor Vehicle Record: Effective **August 8, 1993**, each client must provide a **certified** motor vehicle record, no more than **sixty (60)** days old, from the state in which he/she is (was) last licensed.
